# Overview of Sector



Mozambique has a long coastline of 2700km with large volume potential of fish catch.



The GOM 5 year Development Plan and National Policy Plan points out the importance of fishery




Majority of production carried out in the central part of the country with low productivity in the North



There is existing Japanese private sector participation





**There is great potential to expand the sector by expanding productivity in Northern parts of the country while creating employment through enhancing linkages in the value chain**
